

War Dogs Performance Task

Class Activity:

War Dogs are trained to serve in the military and to help protect their human partners during times of war. In preparation for your performance task, you will now discuss the topic of War Dogs.

Part 1: We have already read the article titled, War Dogs, go back and look at the questions that you answered and discuss the main ideas from the article.

Part 2: Read the article titled, Military Working Dogs: What Happens After They Serve and answer the following questions with your partner. Your answers to these questions will not be scored. They will help you and your classmates think about the topic of War Dogs, which should help you answer the questions. You will have 15 minutes to answer these questions.

Question 1: What happens to these dogs after their service in the military?

Question 2: What happened to these dogs prior to 2000, is that fair?

Question 3: Who do you think should adopt these dogs after their military service is over? Why?
