Reopening Findings from the Center for Educational Effectiveness (CEE)

## 43,000 Educational Stakeholders Reveal the Issues Facing School Reopening

The Center for Educational Effectiveness (CEE) worked with 27 districts, members of the Reopening Washington Schools Workgroup, and industry leaders to launch the EES-Reopening Survey to inform, guide, and learn from the largest set of educational stakeholders surveyed on reopening in the state of Washington—over 43,000 responses.

**6,000** Washington school staff,  
**10,000** students, and  
**27,000** parents

told CEE how **video conferencing** worked for them:

**67%** of teachers felt virtual meetings helped them feel connected to their students

**55%** of students felt virtual meetings helped them feel connected to their teachers

**63%** Parents were slightly more optimistic about how well their students connected with their teachers, but personally felt even less connected to the teachers at less than half (46%)

**Nearly 1/3** of parents were unsure of whether they were able to connect with teachers or not

**84%** of teachers revealed, "I provided students timely feedback on their learning" while only,

**61%** of students, and only

**57%** of parents agreed
